Program Cost

US Flight Co has the following career focused flight programs that are designed to get a student from zero experience to career ready in less than a year.

Program Length

Most of our students graduate within 7 - 12 months from their start date. In the rare case a student is unable to graduate within this time US Flight Co works with the student to complete the program in the quickest time possible.

What The Student Gets With The Program

Fast Track CFI Program: Students enrolled in this program receive the following:

- Private Pilot, Instrument Rating, Commercial Pilot, Certified Flight Instructor Rating. The student graduates with 260 flight hours.
- All Materials and equipment with the exception of an iPad.
- Industry Leading Online Training Library
- 380 Hours of 1 on 1 focused instruction
- All third party testing fees for 1st attempt

<u>Fast Track Airline Pilot Program:</u> Students enrolled in this program receive the following:

- Private Pilot, Instrument Rating, Commercial Pilot, Certified Flight Instructor, Certified Flight Instructor Instrument, Multi-Engine Commercial, and Multi-Engine Instructor. The student graduates with 295 flight hours.
- All Materials and equipment with the exception of an iPad.
- Industry Leading Online Training Library
- 480 Hours of 1 on 1 focused instruction
- All third party testing fees for 1st attempt

Typical Pathway After Graduation

Once students graduate they're qualified to get an entry level commercial pilot job. Types of jobs these students are qualified for include: flight instructor, pipeline patrol pilot, aerial survey pilot, skydiving pilot, entry level freight pilots, banner towing pilot, FAR part 91 pilot, etc. We hire many of our students as flight instructors after they complete the program.

The entry level commercial pilot job has two primary roles. To build flight time, and to provide an income for the pilot. Pilots will typically spend 1.5 - 2.5 years in this entry level pilot job role.

Once the pilot builds enough time, they typically move onto the airlines, corporate aviation, or another high paying pilot job.

Payments / Loan Structure

US Flight Co uses a 3 payment structure for our fast track programs. 1st payment is due to secure a spot in the program, the 2nd payment is due after completing private pilot, the 3rd and final payment is due after completing the instrument rating. Each payment is $\frac{1}{3}$ of the program price.

It's recommended the student has deferred, interest only, or lower payments while they're in the fast track training program (12 months). This allows the student to focus on training.

Students are able to hold a part-time or in some cases a full-time job while training.

About US Flight Co

US Flight Co was founded by Anthony Fowler and Michael Sawyer. Both Michael and Anthony have been in the aviation industry for over a decade with experience from different aspects such as maintenance, running FBOs (Fixed Base Operator) etc. In 2020 Anthony and Michael started US Flight Co to provide a path for aspiring pilots that doesn't take 4 years and more than \$200,000 in student loans. They started with one aircraft and grew to seven.

We maintain a very high success rate with students typically passing checkrides on their first attempt. Students in our fast track programs are allowed to create their own schedule. This is great for students who also work. We try to keep students on a 5 - 7 flights per week schedule. This ensures students finish within the 12 month timeframe.
